What's Involved?

We promote strategies to support communication through different types of play:

Week 1 - Pretend Play

Week 2 - Sound Play

Week 3 - Messy Play

Week 4 - Books

Week 5 - Physical Play

What do you need to know?

We need at least 1 parent/carer to come with your child for every session.

The sessions are mostly free play with your child, but we will discuss and model all of the strategies with you while you play together, and give you other activity ideas.

We'll support you to practise key strategies with you while you play together.

**My child already sees a
Speech and Language
Therapist in your service.
Can I come anyway?**

No, if your child is already under our service it is best to discuss how you can help your child with your current therapist.

**Is it the same as an initial
assessment or 'drop-in'
clinic?**

No. This is a course for parents/carers. It is not intended to replace a child's face-to-face.

**Can I bring my child
and his/her siblings?**

Where possible we ask that siblings do not attend as numbers are restricted and the session ideally requires 1:1.
