Aims of the training:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• To gain a fuller understanding of anxiety</li> <li>• To know how anxiety can affect children and young people on the autism spectrum</li> <li>• To provide strategies to support those with anxiety</li> </ul>

<b>Pupil Voice</b>

Aims of the training:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Understand how sensory integration typically develops and how it may impact on those with autism</li> <li>• To understand how sensory differences may impact on those with autism</li> <li>• To have a range of strategies and approaches to support children and young people with sensory differences</li> </ul>
